

SCS DRESS CODE

PURPOSE

The purpose of the SCS dress code is two-fold:

- To create an atmosphere of higher achievement through higher standards
- To minimize distractions on campus and in the classroom

MODESTY

At SCS, each student is expected to be modestly and appropriately attired and groomed at all times. Although modesty is a relative term, for our standards, modesty can be describes as avoiding the following:

- Tight-fitting clothing
- Revealing clothing
- Visible undergarments
- Pants/shorts that are too baggy or sag
- Garments landing well above the knee

OTHER

- Students in 5th - 8th grade are required to wear an official SCS gym shirt and shorts that are purchased from SCS.
- Uniforms must be clean, free from holes/excessive wear, and fit the student properly (not excessively tight or baggy).
- Students may wear undershirts however the undershirts must follow the shirt color guidelines and are **not** to show from under the polo shirt sleeves.

The approved options and broad variety of colors and styles permitted by our dress code allow for personal expression on campus, while still showing our students that what they wear or how they dress is not as important as the welfare of their mind, body, and spirit.

Our guidelines take the focus off how one dresses, lessen distractions, and showcase who the student really is.

BOTTOMS

- All students must wear standard school uniform style pants or shorts.
- Dockers style school uniform pants and shorts are acceptable insofar as they do not have cargo/utility pockets.
- Shorts must be mid-thigh length or longer.
- Girls may also wear skirts, skorts, and jumpers. All must be mid-thigh length or longer.
- School colors for bottoms are navy blue or tan/khaki.



FOOT WEAR

- Students may wear running/athletic shoes, boots, sandals with straps or buckles, or dress shoes.
- Students are **not** permitted to wear flip flops or heels higher than 1-inch.
- Running/athletic shoes are required for gym class.
- Winter boots may only be worn to and from school and at recess time.

TOPS

- All students must wear plain, solid color polo-style shirts.
- Shirts must have a collar and be free of logos.
- Shirts can be long or short sleeve.
- Undershirts must follow the shirt color guidelines and are NOT to show from under the polo shirt sleeves.
- School colors for shirts are navy blue, gray or primary red.



SPIRIT WEAR

- Students may only wear official SCS Spirit Wear on Fridays with their uniform pants, skirt, or jumper. Other spirit days may be announced throughout the year along with specific guidelines for that day.
- SCS Special Edition items and fleece can be worn during the school day.
